



NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY SELECTION PROCEDURE



To be eligible for National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) consideration at CJHS, 7th grade students must meet the following criteria:

Enrollment: The student must have been enrolled for the entire first semester of the current school year at Coolidge Junior High School (Semester 1).

GPA: The student must have a minimum Cumulative GPA of 3.5.

Candidate Information Form: Students must complete a Candidate Information Form, which includes questions about their leadership, service, character, and involvement in school or community activities.

Essays: Students may be asked to write essays that reflect their commitment to the core values of NJHS, such as leadership, service, and character.

Submit Teacher Recommendation Forms

Interview Process: students will be invited to participate in an interview process with the faculty council.

Meeting All Deadlines: The selection procedure begins during 3rd Quarter. It is essential that students meet all specified deadlines for forms, essays, and other requirements to be eligible for the induction ceremony during 4th Quarter.
